4.20PM - 4.40PM	 TAKAHISA YAMAGUCHI (LIGHTING DESIGNER) CAPITASPRING - FROM DRAWING BOARD TO REALITY CapitaSpring is a 280-metre-tall building in Singapore designed by Bjarke Ingels Group. Its exterior lighting integrates harmoniously with the structure's architecture, landscape and function. This presentation unpacks its design philosophy and unveils its techniques of discreet lighting where effects can be felt even though it is invisible even in photographic documentation. SPEAKER Taka is a Japanese lighting designer and an Associate at Nipek Singapore, has worked on an extensive range of projects from mixed-use developments in the heart of Singapore's Central Business District to high-end hospitality ventures.
4.40PM - 5.00PM	 MATT MARSHALL (LIGHTING DESIGNER) A BEACON FOR BUSINESS: CIRCULAR LIGHTING DESIGN AND THE WORKPLACE With paradigm shifts underway in sustainable design practices in architecture, the lighting industry can play a big part in minimising its impact on the environment by incorporating circular lighting design and specification strategies. Supported with case studies, this talk will shed light on ways to repurpose existing lighting technologies to conserve energy and reduce cost. SPEAKER Matt Marshall has worked in the lighting industry for over 25 years across the greater APAC region. Having studied illumination engineering at university, he holds a firm and passionate belief that good lighting and sensible design not only add to the health and well-being of inhabitants and users, but also contribute to the fight against climate change.
5.00PM - 5.20PM	 TOH YAH LI (LIGHTING DESIGNER) THE TRANSFORMATIVE POWER OF LIGHT Discover the transformative power of lighting. This session examines how effective use of lighting strategies while being sensitive to the environment can improve well-being, enhance human connections and create environments to support plant life. Through case studies like the Singapore Pavilion for World Expo Dubai 2020, Parkroyal Collection Marina Bay and Meyer House, the talk reveals how lighting is one key component of architectural and biophilic designs. SPEAKER Yah Li Toh (CLD, IALD, IES) is the Principal of Light Collab. Shortlisted as Designer of the Year for Singapore President's Design Award 2018 and 2020, she is also a recipient of numerous lighting awards including the SkillsFuture Fellowship Award 2019. Often invited to talk about lighting, she is also an educator and facilitates workshops for design and lighting at tertiary institutions.
